


Solomon McNair



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 3^d day of April 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Samuel McLean for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 14th day of April 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio, on the West bank of Big Beaver Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Samuel McLean Called Stratton Containing four Hundred and thirty four Acres and Allowance of six pr. Cent for Roads.
