



Situate in Woodberry township Huntingdon County containing forty two acres & 46 perches and allowance Surveyed the 19th day of November 1811 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Miller dated October 18th 1811. —

Note - When I surveyed this land a considerable part of it was cleared and under good fence. the house shown to me was an old Cabin with no Roof nor door neither Chunks, & nor Daub, & about 12 by 16 feet in the Logs & about six feet high a log cut out of the side where at a person might go in
