



The Draught of a tract of land situate on the south side of the west branch of Susquehanna River opposite & below the young women's Town in Bald Eagle Township Centre County containing two hundred and eighteen acres Eighty seven perches and allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed the 15th day of October 1811 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Hugh Milliken dated the 12th day of September 1811.

Hugh Milliken actually resides on the ground with his family, has a squared Log House one story and a half high 36 feet by 16 - about sixteen acres of clear Land and grain of different Sorts growing thereon, and agreeable to the best information the Land was first improved in February 1807
