



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Sept. 5<sup>th</sup> 1826 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John McDonald for ten acres of land dated August 7<sup>th</sup> 1826, but contains twenty two acres and 152 perches and allowance of six per Cent for highways. Situate on the South side of Ten Mile Creek in East Bethlehem Township W. County. On the above land there is a Cabin built in the year 1814 by James Gowl and about 7 acres improved by James Perry. The improvement appears older than the house, but how much I could not ascertain. I suppose 7 or 8 years at least
