



In pursuance of a warrant dated March 28<sup>th</sup> 1786 there was survey'd for John Moore the above described tract of land containing seventy acres and allowance proportioned to six & cent for roads & adjoining land of John Creigh - Hugh Davison and others late <sup>in</sup> Pitt township now Plumb township and late Westmoreland now Alleghaney County survey'd October 15<sup>th</sup> 1790.
