



A draught of a tract of land called — situate above the Gapp of the Mountain where Tobys Creek comes through & on the North West side of the East Branch of Susquehanna river adjoining land surveyed for Nathaniel Falconer in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred & one acres & three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of six & cent for roads & ^{ts} surveyed the 21st day of August 1775 for George Mifflin in pursuance of a warrant dated the 10th day of May 1773.
