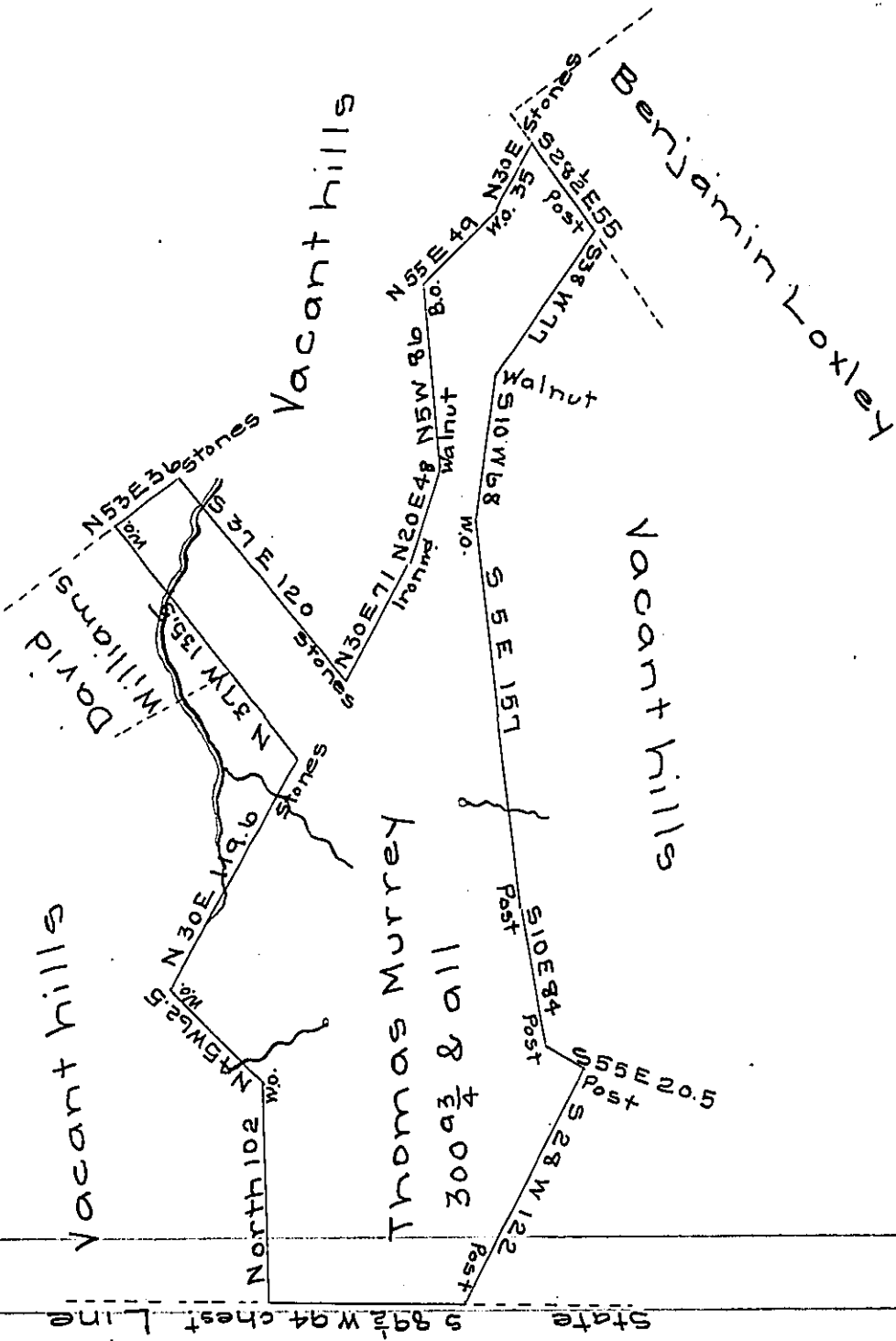


Note, this Survey was made in part in April 1788 but was found to interfere with Benjamin Loxley which error is hereby rectified and the quantity cut off taken, in another place
