



A draught of a tract of land called Strawberry Hill, situate in Turbutt Township in the County of Northumberland surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of June 1773 for John M<sup>c</sup> Williams in pursuance of a warrant dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of October 1772 containing one hundred & nineteen acres & allow<sup>ce</sup> of six acres & cent & c<sup>a</sup>.
