

Situate on the waters of the Clearfeild Creek Frankstown town-ship Huntingdon County containing 396° 33° and the usual allowance surveyed the 24th of October 1788 in pursuance of warrant dated the 14-day of July 1785.

NOTE a return of survey was made on this warrant by which George Woods Esquire containing 40105 30 his survey being in the Chest manor is the reason why the above survey was made and returned - this note made by Mr Canan ye 23d Sept. 1791.

NOTE also the survey above referred to was Retdintoye Secretarys Office for Patenting the 1st. March 1790 -
