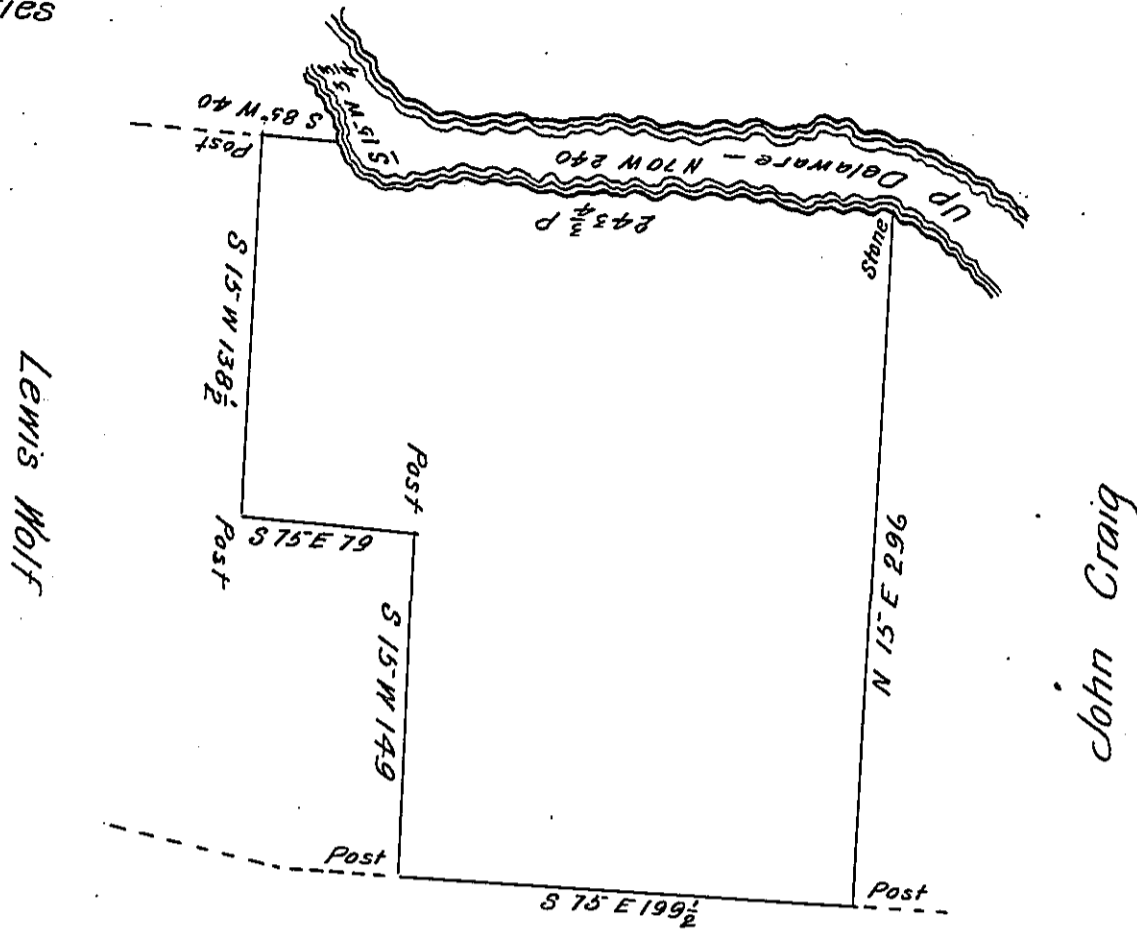

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> July 1792 Surveyed the 26 August 1794. to Thomas Martin the above described tract of land situate on Delaware River about half a mile from the mouth of Leckawaxin-in the County of Northampton Containing four hundred and eighteen acres fifty perches & the allowance of six P Cent &c<sup>a</sup>
