Being part of a larger tract of 197 1/2 72 perches & allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Which was surveyed in pursuance of an order of Survey granted George Mannor dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of December 1767 No 4657. Surveyed and laid off the above part for Jacob Shockey the 6<sup>th</sup> of December 1826.
