



The Draught of a tract of land situate in Walker Township Centre County containing one hundred and eighty four Acres thirty seven perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1816 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William McEwen bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1813. And now to wit on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1817 the improvements on the above described tract of land consists of a two story log dwelling House & Stable about twelve Acres of cleared land with several Fruit Trees on the premises and a family actually residing thereon first improved in September 1807.
