



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 5<sup>d</sup> of July following of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Sumbury in the County of Northumberland being numbered in the general plan of said Town six and granted to George Nagle Esq. containing in length North and South one hundred and seventy feet and in Breadth East and West sixty feet bounded Westward by River Street Northward by Mulberry Alley Eastward by Lot number Seven and Southward by the Square in said Town as by the general Plan thereof remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
