



The above draught describes 20° 56' and allowance of 6% per for roads and high ways situate in Sadsbury Township in the County of Chester survey for Aaron Musgrave by virtue of a warrant dated the 8th day of the month commonly called March 1750 the right whereof is now vested in Joseph Moore surveyed the 11th mo. 1763 & certified by P Woodward - -

N.B. as the above survey being variant from one formerly made it is desired that the other survey become void and the above returned in the room thereof as the above survey comprehends more land than the former Notwithstanding it is agreeable to all parties concerned as far as appears certified this 29th of 11th mo 1770 for Thomas Lightfoot Surveyor P-T Woodward - -
