



The above is a draught of a survey made the 7th of April 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Martin for 400 acres of land dated the 14th of April 1792 situate north and west of the river Ohio on the west bank of Big Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to Christopher Marshall called Steple containing four hundred acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads
