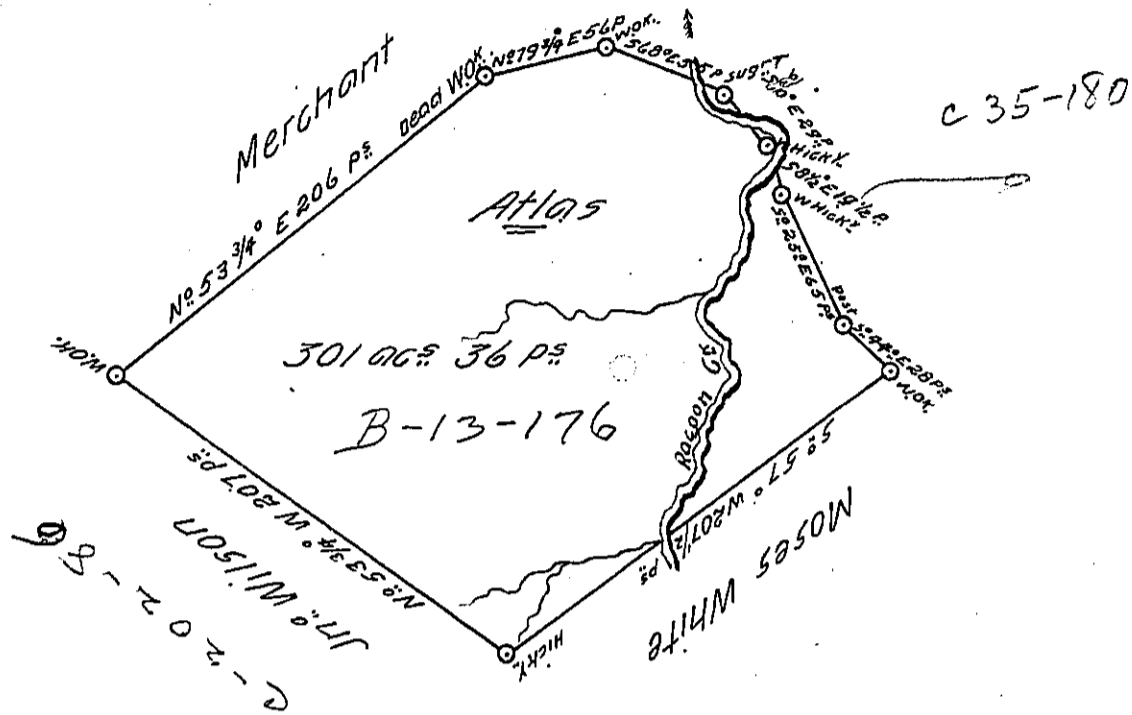


By the certifi<sup>c</sup> produced & filed in the Surrv. Genl's office ~~the~~

A draught of a survey called "Atlas" situate on Racoon Cr. in Washington  
County containg 301 acs 36 ps strict measure executed Decem<sup>r</sup>. 14<sup>th</sup> 1787 in  
consequence of a certifi<sup>c</sup> for 400 acs granted to Sam<sup>l</sup> Merchant by the comm-  
issioners appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the claims to unpatented lands in  
Monong<sup>a</sup> York<sup>a</sup> and Ohio which certificate is endorsed as duly entered with  
the County surveyor but does not appear upon the list of Entries transmit-  
ted to us from the Surrv. Generals Office

Note A survey was executed for Samuel Merchant on this same certifi<sup>c</sup>.  
June ye 9<sup>th</sup> 1785 which survey was cavetted by Jr<sup>s</sup> Wilson the tract is here  
resurveyed the lines altered and a part left out in order to accommodate  
the dispute tis requested to withdraw the first return & receive this in its  
place
