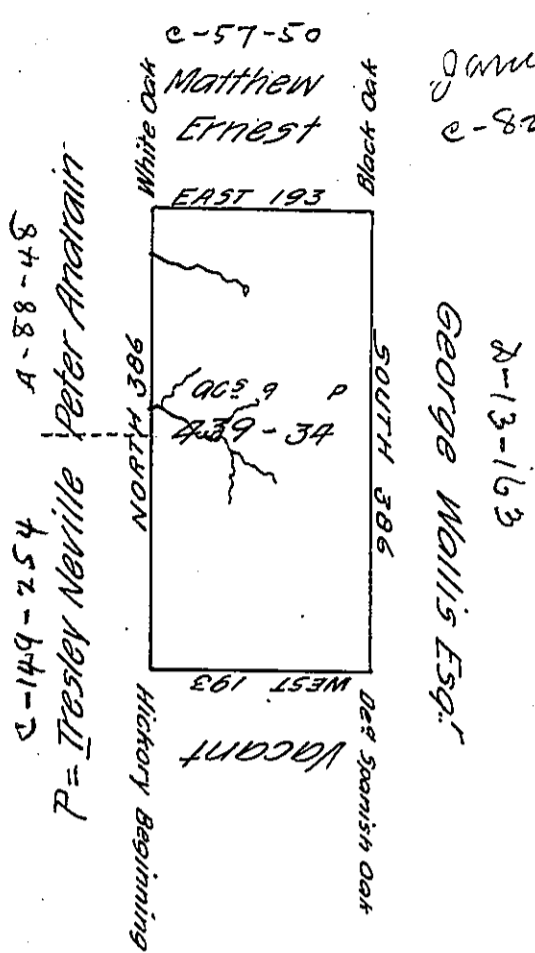

The above is a draught of a survey made May the 21<sup>st</sup> 1794  
 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John M<sup>c</sup>Dowell for 400 acres  
 of land dated February the 10<sup>th</sup> 1794 situate North and West of  
 the River Ohio adjoining Peter Andrain to the Eastward and  
 lying South of the large stream which empties into Big Beaver  
 Creek on the waters of Brush Creek in Destrict N<sup>o</sup> 9 called  
 Black Oak Ridge containing four hundred thirty nine acres and  
 thirty four poles together with the usual allowance of six P<sup>r</sup> cent  
 for roads
