In pursuance of a warrant of 400 acres granted to James McClure dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1816 was surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1830 the above described tract of land containing 212<sup>95</sup> 119 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c and that \_\_\_\_\_ was residing on the same under said McClure and there appeared upwards of 15 acres cleared fenced and in a state of cultivation situate in Sadsbury township Crawford County Pennsylvania
