Including an improvement first began the first day of May 1796, Whereon a family of persons have resided ever since the commencement of the improvement & have annually raised grain thereon, in now Shade Township Somerset County, and Surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1818 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1802.
