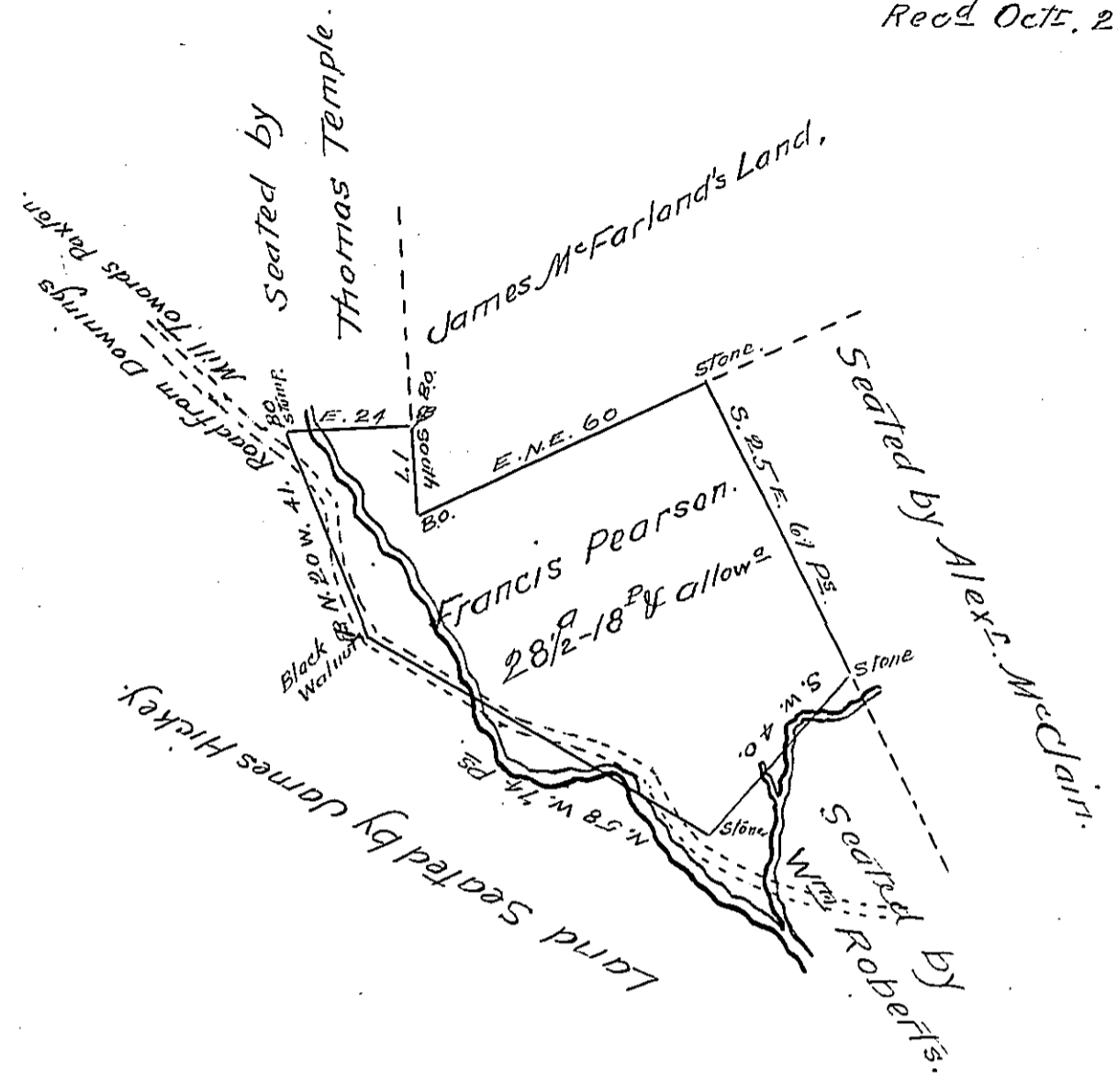


Recd Oct. 22, 1765.
