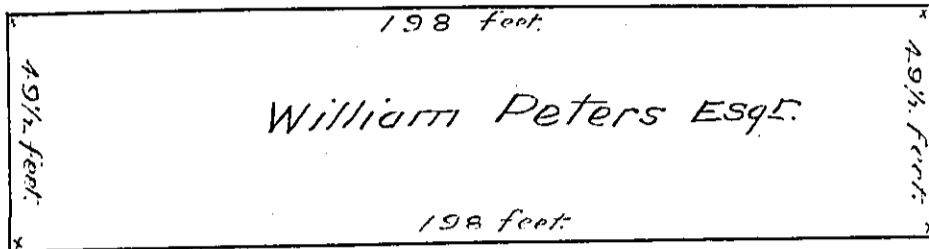

In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 28th April 1769 granted to William Peters Esq^r for a City Lot (in lieu of a Lot laid out to him on Fourth Street in right of the Original Purchase of John Brothers) Surveyed for the said William Peters Esq^r on the 12th day of September 1769 the said Lot Situate on the West side of Third Street from Delaware Containing in Breadth on said Third Street 49 1/2 feet and in Length 198 feet Bounded Eastward with Third Street Northward with the Rev^d. Doct^r. William Smiths Ground and Westward and Southward with Vacant Ground

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 24th day of February 1770.
