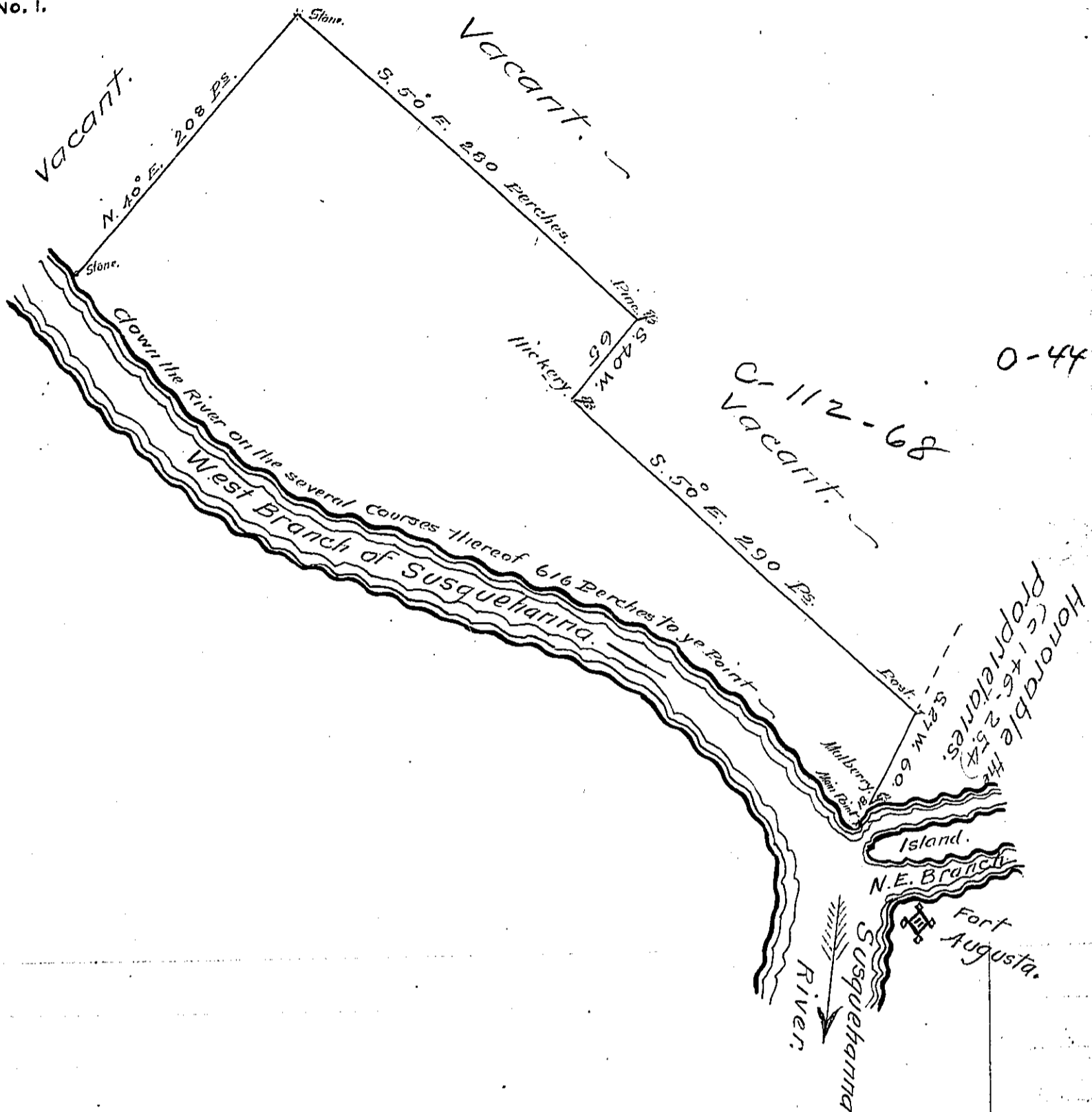

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 5th Day of -
 January 1769 - Surveyed the 23^d day of February 1769,
 for the Use of the Honorable the Proprietaries of the
 Province of Pennsylvania, the above described Tract
 of Land situate on the West Branch of the River Sus-
 quehanna, in the Forks of said River, at the main Point,
 in the County of Berks, containing five hundred -
 Acres, and the usual Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. -
 Wm. Scull Dep^y. Survr.

 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
