N°3 Containing two Acres & one hundred and forty eight perches & allowance Being part of a tract formerly Containing 11^{as} 96^{ps} & allowance but agreeable to a late Survey 12^{as} 1/2. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted William Dixon for 12^a Dated the 2nd day of June 1788. Resurveyed and laid off for David Dixon the 8th day of April 1817.
