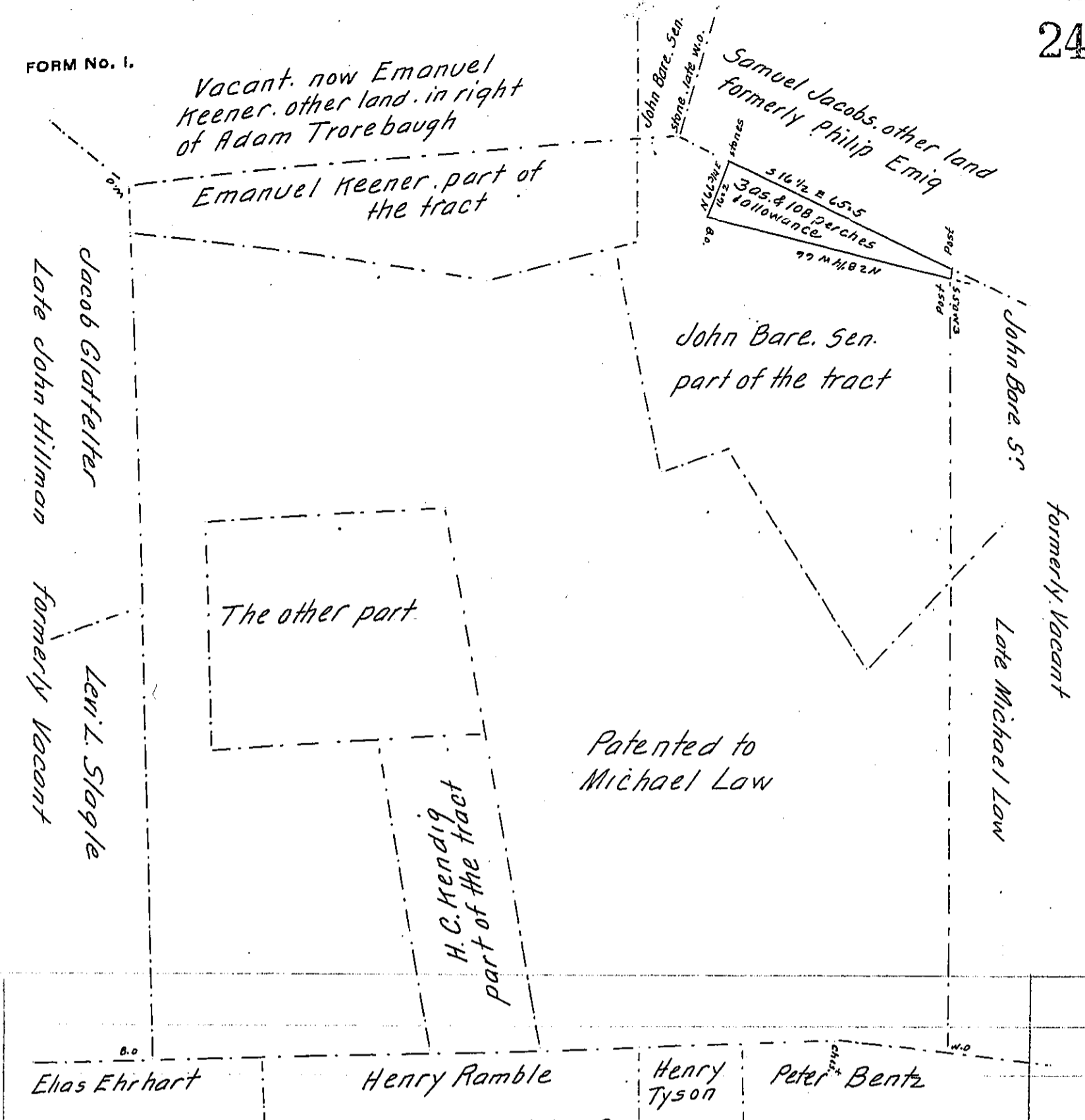


FORM NO. 1.

Which was Originally Surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of October 1751, by George Stevenson, late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>as</sup> granted to Hans Nicholas Maak, Bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1750. Since divided & c. Now on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, A.D. 1871. Examined, Calculated and found Correct, and at the request of Samuel Jacobs, the present owner, the Same is Returned for Confirmation & for to patent the Same.
