



Situate on the East Side of Tussey's Mountain in Liberty (formerly Hope-well) township Bedford County. Containing 180 acres 140 perches and the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 18th day of Dec. 1869 for Robert H. Powell. Being a part of a larger tract of Land Containing 440^{a.s} & allowance. Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted Jacob Miller dated 19th Sept. 1794.
