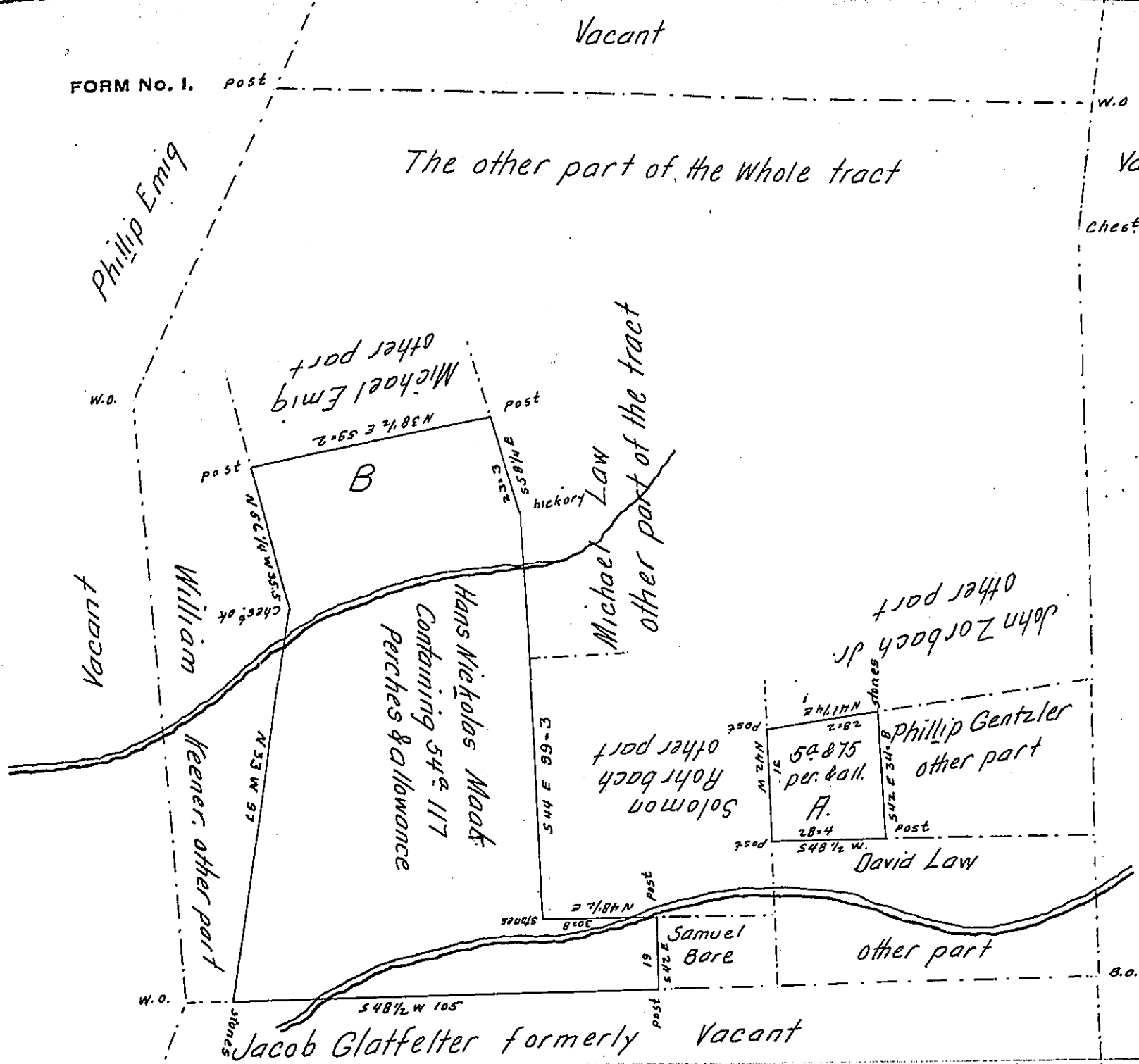

 150^a granted to Hans Nicholas Maak bearing date the 10th day of September
 1750. Since Resurveyed and divided &c. Now on the 4th day of August A. D.
 1837. Examined & Corrected the above &c. at the request of John Bare, the
