



A Draught of a tract of land called Spring Grove. Situate on the Waters of Beaver Meadow run. about two Miles to the northward of the Old Road leading from Bedford to Fort Pitt. adjoining lands of Steve Carmick. John Keighn. Saml Taylor. and Frederick Hagens. in Cumberland County. Containing three hundred and one Acre - and usual allowance of Six pr. cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> day September 1770 for Joseph Mather of the County of Phila. by Virtue of a warrant granted to him the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July in the year aforesaid. Now Situate in Township Jenner Somerset County. A part of it Resurveyed for Lawrance Spiegel in right of the above Joseph Mather. in order that a Patent May Issue to the said Lawrance Spiegel for 174 Acres 105 perches and Allowance the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1867.
