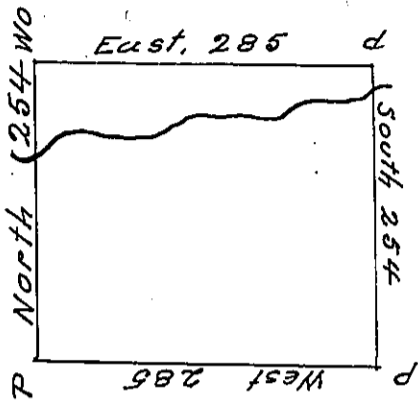

 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p Cent &c
