In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain lands therein mentioned & by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office from John Lukens Esq^t Surveyor Gen^l for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22nd day of August 1783.

The above tract of land containing Two hundred & sixteen acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6p Cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 10th day of June 1785. by
