



Situate on the waters of Standing Stone Creek in Henderson Township Huntingdon County containing One hundred forty nine acres 33 Perches of the usual allowance, it being part of a tract of Land first surveyed the 24th day of June 1766 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William McFunn dated the 3rd of June 1763. The Original Survey was then said to contain 197^{as} of allowance This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said Tract the 16th of April 1819. Examined ^{Corrected} & approved the 1st of Feb'y 1832
