



Situate on the waters of Quermahoning Creek including his improvement in Quermahoning Township (formerly Bedford) now Somerset County and Surveyed the 15th day of March 1799 by John Wells Esquire late deputy surveyor as appears by his official Draught remaining in my office in pursuance of a Warrant Granted unto James Mc Mullin dated the 25th day of February 1774. Certified the 14th day of May 1806.
