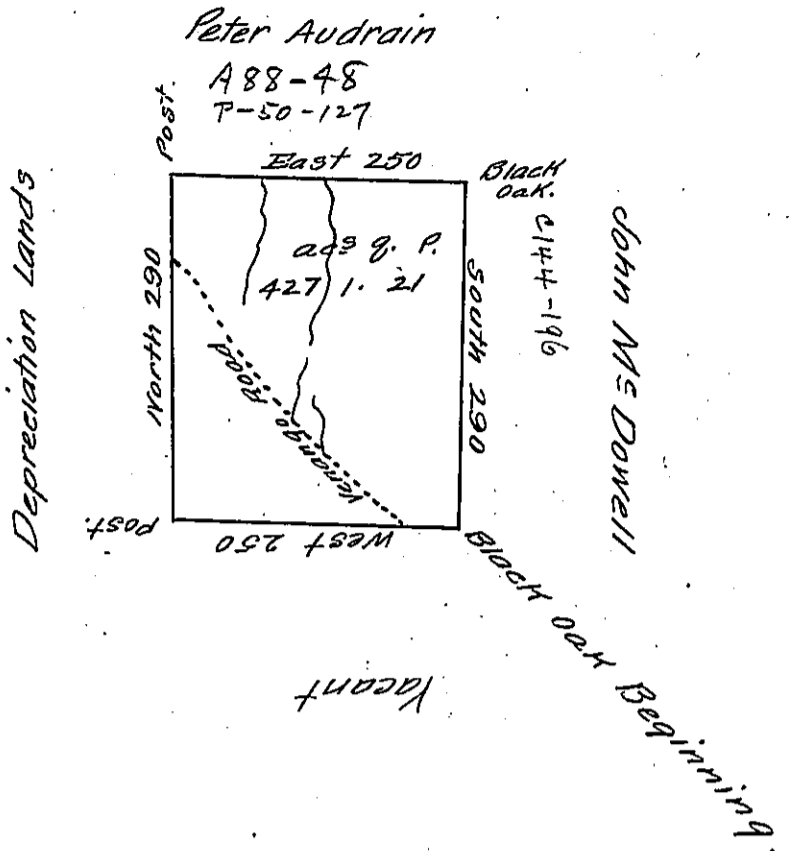

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 24<sup>th</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Presley Neville for 400 acres of land Dated Feb<sup>y</sup> the 10<sup>th</sup> 1794. Situate adjoining Peter Audrain and on the south side of said large stream which empties into Big Beaver North and West of the River Ohio in District No 9 Called Neville's Grove Containing four hundred twenty seven acres one quarter and twenty one poles together with the usual allowance of six p<sup>cs</sup> Cent for Roads
