 Granted unto Laughlin M^cClane dated the 21st day of June Anno Dom
 1738 the above described Tract of Land was surveyed on or about the 26th day of
 the 1st month 1768 for the above named David Walker Situate on
 Brandewine Creek chiefly in East Caln Township in the County of
 Chester Containing 92 Acres beside the allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
