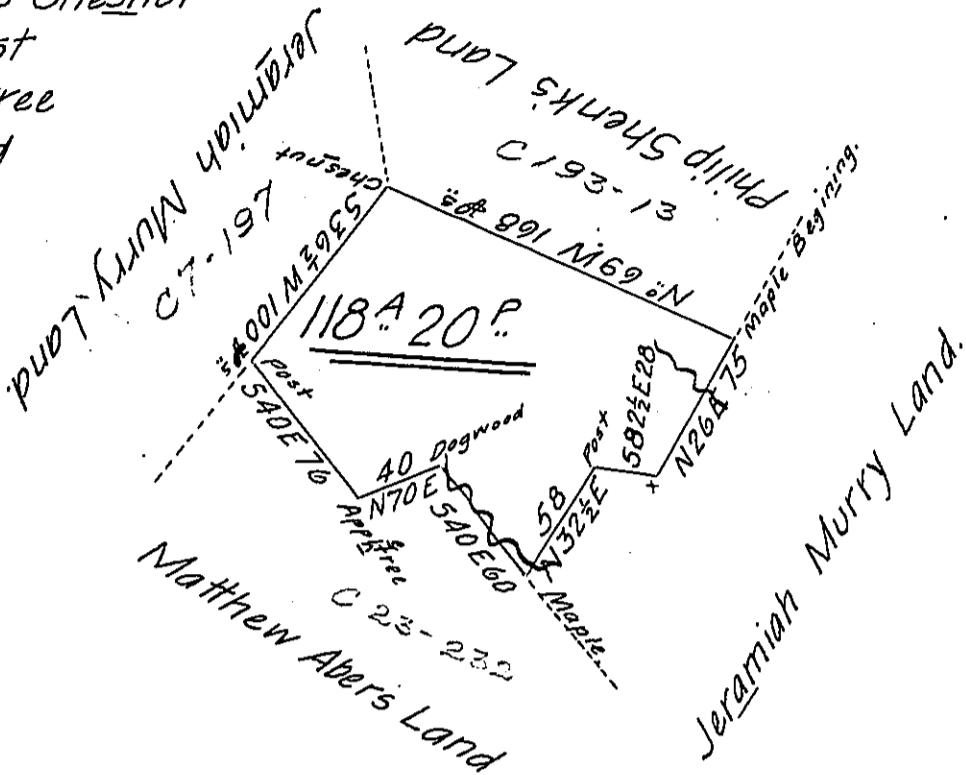

Situated in Plum Township Allegheny County on the Waters of Turtle Creek Containing One hundred & Eighteen Acres & Twenty perches & Allowance of Six ½ Cent for Roads &c.
