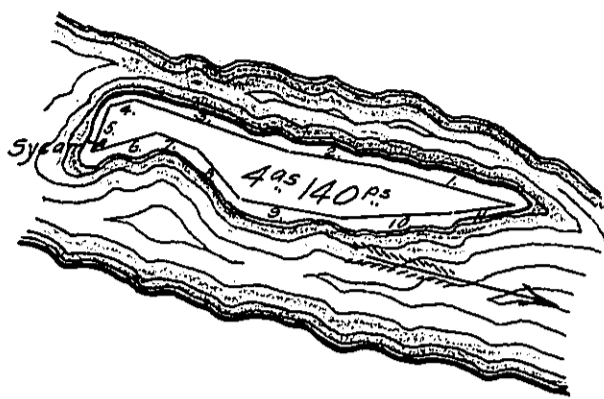

at about equal distance between the Graveyard lot in the West end of
the town of Franklin, on the South branch of French Creek, and an
Island near the North bank of said creek, heretofore Surveyed,
and Warrant granted to A. McCalmont con^g 3 ac.

Surveyed July 10th 1843 to Alex^r McCalmont in pursuance of
a Warrant granted to the said A. McCalmont dated June 24th 1843. con-
taining four acres & one hundred & forty perches.
