Containing two hundred and twenty Acres and one hundred & two perches with the allowance of Six per cent. Situate in the Last Purchase, Lycoming County and Township and bounded as above described.

Note the improvement is house where Wm Murry Resides with his family a barn with about Ten Acres cleared Land improvement began in 1813. The part marked B is supposed to interfere with John Hays and is claimed by Thomas Hall by his improvement
