



Draught of Eighty one Acres and 92 perches and the Allowance of Six p<sup>cent</sup> for Roads &c. Part of a larger Tract of Land situate on the heads of Hamiltons Run Tuscarora Valley in Lack Township (formerly Cumberland) now Mifflin County and appears to have been Survey'd by William Maclay late Deputy Surveyor the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1764 and said to contain 261 Acres & 107 perches &c. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to John McKnight the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1762

On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1802 Divided for John Smiley now in Possesion of the above Part.
