



The above red lines describe a tract of land situate in Tyrone Township Perry County Containing twenty six acres Seventy one perches and allowance of Six Per Cent for roads &c. Originally surveyed May the 31st 1771 in pursuance of a warrant granted William Miller dated February the 11th 1771 for 50^{ac} which tract has been included in a Survey made in pursuance of a warrant granted by the Commonwealth of Penn^a to Robert McCalley dated March the 11th 1796 as represented by the yellow lines. The part included in the red lines is owned by Henry Kline
