



By Virtue of a Warrant from ye Proprietaries <sup>for 150<sup>ac</sup></sup> dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1734. Surveyed to Engle Peter a tract of land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a Post a Corner of Arnold Huffnail's land thence by the same South West thirty five perches & a half perch to a dead Black Oak, thence by S<sup>d</sup> Huffnail's land South East one hundred and six perches to a Large Black Oak thence by land laid out to Casper Wister North East thirty five perches & a half perch to a post thence by S<sup>d</sup> Engle Peter North West one hundred perches and the same Course by S<sup>d</sup> Huffnail six perches to the place of Beginning. Containing twenty two acres with the usual allowance of six P Cent.

Surveyed Novemb<sup>r</sup> 27 1735.
