



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty seventh day of February 1733. ^{for 150^a} Surveyed unto Engle Peter a tract of land Situate in Oley in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a Post a Corner of Arnold Huffnails land thence by land of Engle Peters North East one hundred and twenty three perches to a Corner Stone, thence by the said Engle Peters Land South East fifty six perches to a Post thence by the last mentioned land North East sixty eight perches to a White Oak, thence by the last mentioned land South East ninety two perches to a Black Oak, thence by land of Andrew Baley North East one hundred & twenty eight perches to a Post thence by Vacant land North West two hundred and ten perches to a Post, thence by Vacant land South West three hundred and nineteen perches to a Post in the line of Arnold Huffnails land, thence by the same South East sixty two perches to the place of Beginning. Containing two hundred & fifty acres with the usual allowance of Six P. Cent. - Surveyed May 31 1735.
