



Survey'd by James Logan's Order the 20th 8^{br} 1718.

In pursuance of a Warrt dated y^e 18th of 9^{br} Anno Dom 1734. Returned into the Secretary's office the 22^d of 9^{br} 1734.

The marked lines of trees being tried in the year 1738. they were found very different from this draught & do but include 300^a & allowance, and if the same were extended according to this, they would include several persons improvem^{ts} who had Warrts & Surveys

Thomas Ewing & Wife therefore Reconveyed this 500^a & c to the Propriet^{rs} who regrants to them the land within the marked lines. Viz 300^a & allow & also pays to T. Ewing 100 pounds in lieu of the 200 acres wanting
