



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarys bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Dom: 1738. Surveyed to Alexander Poor a tract of land joyning on the east side of Swataroe Creek in Derry township & County of Lancaster. Begining at a White oak tree by the said creek, thence by an Improvmt of James Morrisons South 70 Degs Et 311 P to a White oak in the line of Rowland Chambers land, then by sd Chambers land North 41 Degs West 318 P to a Spanish Oak, then N 20 Degs West by sd land Seventy eight perches to Said Creek at a marked White Oak then down by the Said Creek along the several Courses thereof three hundred ninety eight perches to the Begining Containing two hundred forty three acres and the usual allowance of six P Ct Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> of April 1738.
