



By Order of the Proprietary. Surveyed on the 30th day of March An^o Dom. 1738 to Arthur Patterson a tract of land. Situate in the township of Donegal in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Black Oak by the side of Sickasalunga Creek, thence by Vacant North West land, 220 perches to a Hickery thence North east 85 perches to a Hickery thence North North West 80 perches to a Black Oak thence North east by east 100 perches to a Hickery thence South 62 deg. East 110 perches to Hickery thence South East 66 perches to a Spanish Oak Standing on the af^{sd} Creek thence Down the Several Courses of the said Creek four hundred fifty eight perches to the place of Beginning. Containing three hundred fifty five acres and the allowance of six acres P. Cent — for Roads & highways.
