



In pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 15th day of July 1740. Resurveyed on the 22^d day of the same Month a Lot of Ground formerly of Edward Luffe now belonging to Samuel Parr (Situat as Shewed in this draught) & have added thereto a small piece of Vacant ground (adjoining the West side of the 5^d Lot) in breadth seven feet and in pursuance of the Warrant afores^d. I have made a Return of both under one description the 27th day of April 1741 into the Secretary's Office in order for Confirmation.
