



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the eighth day of March Anno Dom 1743. The above described tract of land was Surveyed unto Jane Jones in the township of Gumru (formerly a part of Robinson township) in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Stone & a Corner of the land of Evan Lloyd Thence South 47 degrees West by Vacant land 65 perches to a Post. Thence North 40 degrees West by a tract of David Jones 107 perches to a Black Oak. Thence South 41 degrees West by the Same 180 perches to a post. Thence North 30° West by another tract of ye Said D^d Jones 120 Perches to a Hickery. Thence North 60 degrees east by the land of Thomas Nicholas and John Jones 250 perches to a Stone Thence South 14 degrees East by ye Land of Evan Lloyd 27 perches to a Stone. Thence South 30 degrees West ye same 20 Per. to a Stone. Thence South 43 degrees east by the Same 120 perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing One hundred & forty six acres beside ye allowance of Six P. Cent.
