



By Virtue of a Warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 4th day of May Anno-1754 or 1753 granted to George Palsgrove the above described tract of land Situate in Low Hill township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing fifty two acres and one half acre of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads. Was Surveyed for the said George Palsgrove (alias Pfaltzgraff) on the 27th day of May Anno-1755.
