Survey'd for James Porter the 10th of the 3rd mo (March) 1752 in pursuance of a Warrant for 10⁰ dated the 13th of January in the same year. Begins ^{at} a Bounded Stump the Beginning of a tract under Maryland Patent called Poplar Valley standing on the South side of Peters Creek at the mouth thereof & running according to the Courses & Distances above mentioned Scale 20 P to an Inch. Situate in Little Britain Township Lancaster County
