



A A small part of the whole tract belonging to Jacob Groud

Situate in Shrewsbury Township York County. Containing wi(obl) the black lines(obl.) above set forth twenty eight acres, sixty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 29 1/4 as & allowance. Originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S on the 3^d day of the 5th Month A. D. 1777 in pursuance of a Warrant for 25^{as} dated the 11th day of May A. D. 1776. and now after excluding the part A agreeably to the lines thereof, as run by Jacob Spangler Esq late D.S. on the 31st day of July A. D. 1804 - the said first above described part (being the residue of the tract) is examined, corrected, calculated, and at the request of the present owner Daniel Groud. returned for Confirmation March 18th 1822.
