



Situate in Newbury township in the County of York containing as above set forth nine acres one hundred and forty eight perches and the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 22^{as} 87 P^{cs} and allowance of land. Surveyed on the 10th day of November 1803 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Baxter for 22^{as} dated the 2nd day of November 1803. The above part Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger tract on the 22nd day of December 1821 and now at the request of William Hoopes the present owner of the said part returned for Confirmation.
