



A draught of a tract of land situate in Derry township Mifflin County containing one hundred and two acres and 41 perches and the allowance of six Per cent for Roads &c. appears Surveyed (by James Harris late Deputy Surveyor) the 25th day of April 1795. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Daniel Gross dated the 21st day of June 1793

Examined the 12th day of November 1803 and appears Correct.

N. B. Altho—the names of the adjoining lands to the above tract are not the Boundaries mentioned in the Warrant on which the Survey was made. Yet as I am convinc^d it is the very land for which the Warrant was taken and as no other Warrant or Claim ever appearing for the same — Therefore at the request of John Gross owner of the above Warrant I send the Return forward.
